Council discussed the proposal by Roger Porter for his property located at 13 Reid Road and the requirement from Stacey Sweezey, Corridor Management Planner, Easter Region, of the Ministry of Transportation for the Township's permission to permit Mr. Porter to do minor work at the intersection of Highway 28 and Reid Road.
